Colonel Chip Fulghum is the Director, Financial Management and Comptroller, Headquarters Air Education and Training Command, Randolph Air Force Base, Texas. As such, he has oversight of a budget of over \$8 billion, pay services for over 100,000 personnel at 13 major bases. Colonel Fulghum received his commission from The Citadel. His comptroller assignments include in three years in non-appropriated funds, three years in cost, ten years in budget, two years as commander and four years as a comptroller.
